Marina Bay Sands celebrates Sands for Singapore with “Wish Dishes”

Donates 50 per cent of proceeds for 21 Wish Dishes towards Make-A-Wish Foundation

Singapore (24 July 2013) – The entire line-up of celebrity chef restaurants and selected tenanted retailers have thrown their weight behind Sands for Singapore Festival, offering a total of 21 Wish Dishes to diners who will get to savour delectable food while doing a good deed.

Through the inaugural Sands for Singapore Festival, happening over 16-18 August, Marina Bay Sands will donate 50 per cent of proceeds from these Wish Dishes to Make-A-Wish Foundation Singapore, a non-profit organization that grants the wishes of children with life-threatening medical conditions.

Marina Bay Sands’ support comes a few months ahead of the official annual Wish Dish campaign, which will take place in October this year.

“Through Sands for Singapore, we are making a strong and early contribution to Make-A-Wish Foundation, even before it starts its official Wish Dish campaign. This is an indicator of how seriously we take charitable causes while we celebrate good food and wine in Marina Bay Sands,” said Tamir Shanel, Vice President of Food & Beverage, Marina Bay Sands. “With the enthusiastic support from our celebrity chef restaurants and tenants, we hope to inspire other restaurants in Singapore to join us in making a difference for the young beneficiaries we support through our food.”

Dr Keith Goh, Chairman, Make-A-Wish Foundation said, “The Wish Dish has become a signature event for us since we first introduced it last year. With the great support of Marina Bay Sands especially with its early support to kick start the campaign, we hope that more restaurants in Singapore will come on board and join us in granting the wishes of our beneficiaries.”

The restaurants participating in the Wish Dish at Marina Bay Sands includes celebrity chef restaurants such as CUT, db Bistro Moderne, Guy Savoy, Pizzeria Mozza, Osteria Mozza, Sky on 57 and Waku Ghin, as well as tenanted restaurants such as Bazin, The Coffee Bean & Tea Leaf Beanstro, The Moluccas Room, High Society, Jin Shan, Rasapura, TWG Tea and 1983 - A Taste of Nanyang.

Diners can look forward to an array of Wish Dishes at the celebrity chef restaurants such as the popular Yankee Burger from db Bistro Moderne and USDA Prime Rib Eye from CUT by Wolfgang Puck. Seafood lovers will be delighted with Wish Dishes such as the Steamed Canadian Halibut and Lobster Mousseline, Clams and herbs Fondue from Sky on 57, and the Roasted Scampi with Vanilla from Waku Ghin. Mozza signatures such as the Egg, Bacon, Yukon Gold Potato, Cippolini & Thyme Pizza and the Bucatini all'Amatriciana will be available as Wish Dishes at Pizzeria Mozza and Osteria Mozza respectively. CUT's Garden of Eden cocktail and any a la carte desserts at Guy Savoy round up the delectable Wish Dish offerings from Marina Bay Sands' celebrity chef restaurants.

Over at the tenanted restaurants, full set meals as well as specialty dishes are offered as Wish Dishes. In particular, local restaurant TWG has created the Trio of Chocolate Mousse infused with Earl Grey Fortune especially for this occasion, using three types of chocolates infused with Earl Grey Fortune and served with smooth vanilla custard. This dessert is part of a set meal which includes a roasted boneless chicken leg glazed with teriyaki sauce and infused with Spice Route tea, sautéed baby carrots and broccoli served with fragrant seaweed rice.
