Celebrity chefs at Marina Bay Sands honoured at Asia's 50 Best Restaurants 2016

Singapore (1 March 2016) – Marina Bay Sands' celebrity chefs Tetsuya Wakuda from Waku Ghin and David Thompson from Long Chim were once again honoured at the Asia's 50 Best Restaurants 2016 awards held last night.
