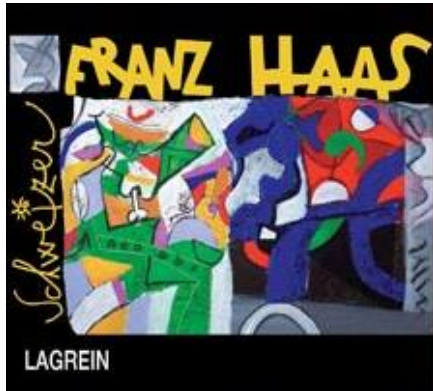

Lagrein is a native grape varietal of the Alto Adige region in Northern Italy and it is made into a robust red wine with intense bouquet under the care of Franz Haas, an Italian with Germanic heritage.

This artisanal wine shows delightful aromas of ripe red berries, fresh grass and violets with lots of concentrated flavours of berry fruits on the palate.

The unique wine label is the artwork of Italian artist Riccardo Schweizer (1924-2004) who studied cubism in Paris under masters such as Pablo Picasso and Joan Mirò.

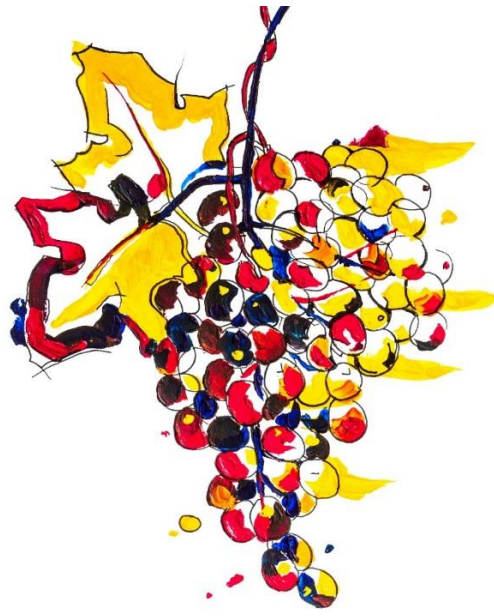

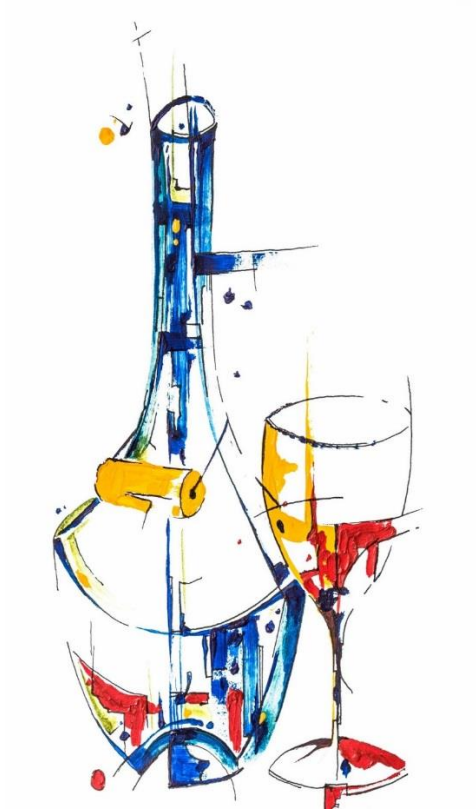
